The Ranch provides a source of healing, balance and peace of mind to underserved children whose full expression is limited by physical, emotional, behavioral, health or financial restraints. Staff and devoted volunteers ensure that each child participates and experiences nature and science learning in our beautiful Hill Country setting. We had the opportunity to visit with, Executive Director Jenn Hartner, to learn more about this fantastic organization.

How does Candlelight Ranch partner with the community? Candlelight Ranch actively outreaches into the school and nonprofit communities to build awareness of the facilities, resources and flexible nature curriculum. The Ranch offers its unique and accessible facilities and innovative customized programming to numerous other nonprofit youth-serving organizations and to schools to enhance and extend their special programming.

Candlelight Ranch currently partners with over 30 central Texas nonprofits and schools including the following agencies and organizations, Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired, Helping Hand Home for Children, The Boys and Girls Clubs of the Highland Lakes, Juvenile Justice for Travis, Burnet and Llano counties, Marble Falls Elementary Life Skills Group, Phoenix Center, Falls Career High School, Leander ISD, Austin ISD, Lake Travis ISD, Marble Falls ISD, Pflugerville ISD and Round Rock ISD.
